Levels of Play

Level I: Clinic Division, very little or no on-course experience.

Level II: Has had basic instruction in full swing, short game, putting, rules and etiquette. Prepared for the course.

Will play 9 holes from flags placed approximately 125 yards from the green or closer on par 3s.

Level III: Can play 9 holes, averaging between 65-75 strokes on a regulation course.

Will play 9 holes from approximately 125 yards in front of forward tees (less on par 3s).

Level IV: Can play 9 holes, averaging between 55 – 64 strokes on a regulation course.

Will play 9 holes from forward tees.

Level V: Plays 18 holes, averaging 110 strokes or better on a regulation course.
